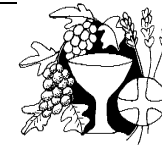

On Saturday last, as you would be aware, Bishop Peter ordained Geoffrey Allen and Duane Fernandez to the Priesthood. The Cathedral was filled to capacity with family and friends, some

travelling from as far as Sweden, Canada and Malaysia, as well as over 50 clergy. Bishop Peter welcomed the first priests in five years to be ordained to the Priesthood in the Diocese of Wollongong. With ordinations come clergy appointments and in this instance they directly affect the Nowra Parish. Fr George who has been with us for only 18 months is being transferred to Wollongong, and Fr Duane has been appointed to Nowra. During his time here in Nowra parishioners have come to acknowledge and appreciate Fr George's zeal, his selflessness and his caring pastoral outreach. The appointments take effect early in the New Year. Hopefully in the not too distant future there will be an opportunity for both welfares and welcomes.
